### EDITORIAL

The objective of this Newsletter is to provide a medium for the rapid dissemination of information on things Achaemenid. This first issue is almost entirely bibliographical in its content. The editor, who is the sole contributor to this issue, expects and will welcome comments, contributions and criticism.

The compilation of the material presented here has been simplified by the availability of two extraordinary resources: The Joseph Regenstein Library of The University of Chicago, and The Research Archives of The Oriental Institute of The University of Chicago. Certain biases of these collections (and of the editor himself) are evident in the range and type of material selected for inclusion. Such biases as there may be do not reflect editorial policy, and I trust that the participation of colleagues specializing un- or under-represented fields will fill the lacunae.

Each of you who receives this issue of PIRRADAZIS should consider this a direct solicitation for information to be included in subsequent issues. While I am not particularly concerned with older bibliographical material, I am happy to include notices of titles I have missed in compiling this list, beginning more or less with 1990, and I am particularly interested in signaling 'obscure' references. I have attempted to be as thorough as possible in my citations, and would appreciate similar consideration in return. It is my inclination not to include citations I have not actually seen; thorough citations will facilitate my search, and may sway me to include unchecked references. I set no limits on the range or type of material which will be included in subsequent issues. Achaemenid or Achaemenian may be construed however each reader or contributor wishes. The only serious limits are cost and timeliness of publication. Current plans are to produce the second issue at the beginning of January 1991. I hope, ultimately, to be able to produce quarterly issues.

This and the second issue of PIRRADAZIS are being sent to interested parties free of charge. The second issue will include information on subscription. In the meantime, contributions from those considering this a worthy cause, and wishing to help defray printing and postage costs will be enthusiastically accepted.
