

How Did This All Begin?


- A need for better communication among academic librarians within PaLA

Open Access is:

- "digital, online, free of charge, and free of most copyright and licensing restrictions. What makes it possible is the internet and the consent of the author or copyrightholder...
- ...compatible with copyright, peer review, revenue (even profit), print, preservation, prestige, quality, careeradvancement, indexing, and other features and supportive services associated with conventional scholarly literature." (P. Suber Open Access Overview)
