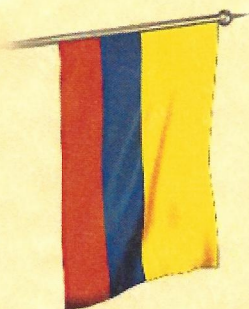

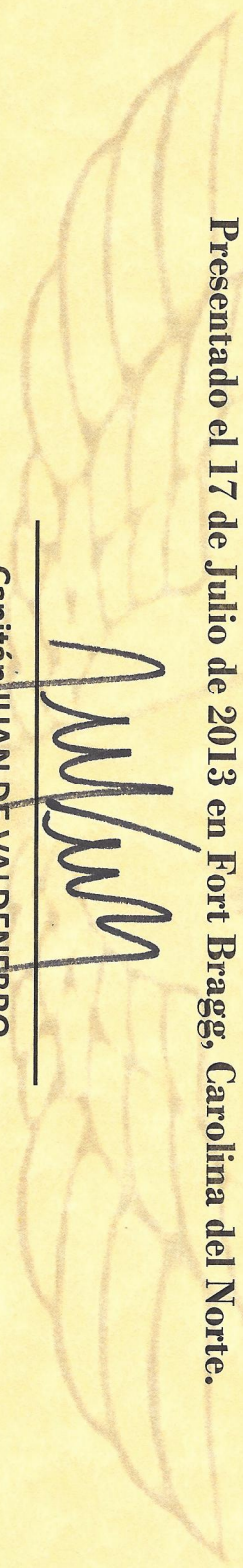
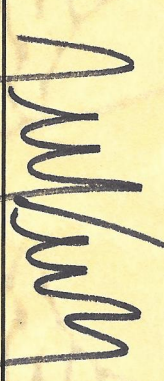

Soldier will hand carry out-processing packet; field Military Personnel Records Jacket (MPRJ) along with associated transfer documents, records, and deployment packet to the gaining PSC or replacement activity.
